



**NOTICE INVITING
STATEMENTS OF PREQUALIFICATION

EQUIPMENT SUPPLY CONTRACT**

**SIXTH WATER FLOW CONTROL STRUCTURE MODIFICATION
Central Utah Water Conservancy District

PREQUALIFICATION

Statements of Prequalification are being solicited by the Central Utah Water Conservancy District (OWNER) for furnishing the following equipment for the Sixth Water Flow Control Structure Modification, along with certain services:

Two axial flow control valves with electrical actuators, two full-port ball valves and electrical actuators, two vertical basket strainers, spare parts, and specialized tools.

Equipment Supplier prequalification is required by the OWNER, and only prequalified Equipment Suppliers will be allowed to submit a proposal for furnishing the subject equipment.

All prospective Equipment Suppliers will be notified by October 7, 2019, if they have been prequalified and approved to propose on this project. Interested Equipment Suppliers may obtain the Prequalification Requirements at no charge from the OWNER at 1426 East 750 North, Suite 400, Orem, Utah 84097, Telephone: 801-226-7141, Fax: 801-226-71, or by download from the OWNER homepage at <http://www.cuwcd.com/>. Instructions for downloads are presented on the homepage. The OWNER anticipates issuing procurement documents to prequalified Equipment Suppliers October 7, 2019 and opening proposals October 21, 2019. Award of a contract for furnishing the subject equipment is anticipated by November 2019. The contract for the subject equipment may subsequently be assigned to the Sixth Water Flow Control Structure Modification construction contractor.

SUBMITTAL OF STATEMENT OF PREQUALIFICATION

Hard copy submission: Statements of Prequalification shall be submitted by interested Equipment Suppliers to the OWNER before 4:00 p.m. (Mountain Daylight Time) on October 2, 2019, for review by the OWNER. Three (3) hard copies of statements shall be delivered to the OWNER's office, located at 1426 East 750 North, Suite 400, Orem, Utah 84097.

Electronic submission: Statements of Prequalification shall also be submitted by the same deadline in one of the following electronic formats:

Via E-mail: Provide one scanned pdf-format copy (compatible with Adobe Reader 10.0 or later) of original documents, sent to the following e-mail address: bart@cuwcd.com. Such e-mail transmission and attachments shall be received by OWNER no later than the date and time prescribed. It is recommended that a test e-mail message be exchanged with this address in advance.

Via USB Flash Drive: Provide one scanned pdf-format copy (compatible with Adobe Reader 10.0 or later) of original documents on a suitable USB flash drive. Include this flash drive with the submission of the hard copies of the Statement of Prequalification. The hard copies and pdf copy shall be received by OWNER no later than the date and time prescribed.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

Adjacent to the existing Sixth Water Flow Control Structure, the project will construct a new below grade flow control vault that includes two water delivery trains with flow capacities ranging from 5 to 50 cfs and 10 to 100 cfs including prolonged deliveries at or near 5 cfs. This facility is owned by the United States Department of Interior and operated and maintained by the Central Utah Water Conservancy District (CUWCD). The modification is being design and implemented by CUWCD, in cooperation with the U.S. Department of Interior under various agreements.

It is anticipated that a separate contract will be awarded to a qualified general contractor for the construction of the facility modification and the installation of the equipment supplied under this contract. The OWNER may assign the contract for the equipment to the general contractor. Submittal review and approval authority would be retained by the OWNER, with the assistance of the Design Engineer. The successful equipment supplier will also provide the services of qualified manufacturer representatives, or their representative during the installation and commissioning of the equipment.

SITE OF WORK

The proposed modification will be completed at the existing Sixth Water Flow Control Structure that is located approximately 40 miles east of Spanish Fork City, which is in Utah County, Utah.
