

NOTICE REQUESTING TECHNICAL PROPOSALS FOR ENGINEERING AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT SERVICES FOR THE CWP VINEYARD WELLFIELD COLLECTOR PIPELINE

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The Central Utah Water Conservancy District (“District”) is seeking Technical Proposals from qualified engineering firms to provide design and construction management services for the CWP Vineyard Wellfield Collector Pipeline project located in Vineyard, Utah. The anticipated scope of work for this project includes preliminary and final design of a 14,000 foot welded steel pipeline with diameters ranging from 30- to 48-inches. The pipeline will collect flow from up to 10 culinary wells and feed into the existing CWP North Shore Aqueduct. Appurtenant facilities and other requirements include turnout, blowoff and air/vacuum release vaults, two 250-300 foot bores beneath existing rail facilities and an 8,700 foot, 24-inch diameter HDPE well-to-waste pipeline.

REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS: Interested firms may download the Request For Proposals from Quest CDN (www.questcdn.com Project ID # 5087386) beginning Tuesday, May 2nd, 2017 for a one-time \$10.00 download fee.

PROPOSALS DUE: To be responsive to this request for engineering services, the engineering firm must submit ten (10) paper copies and one pdf copy (on a flash drive) of the Technical Proposal to the Central Utah Water Conservancy District, Attn: Cort Lambson, P.E., Project Manager, 355 West University Parkway, Orem, Utah 84058-7303, no later than **12:00 Noon, Friday, May 26th, 2017**.

SELECTION OF QUALIFIED FIRMS: The District will form a selection committee. It is the intent of the District that the selection will be made only from the Technical Proposals. The Technical Proposal will be the primary basis for determination of the selected. However, if determined necessary by the District, a short-list of qualified firms may be developed and interviews requested with such firms in order to make the selection. In such case, the District will send a notification to each selected firm making the short-list and will schedule a time for the oral presentation/interview with information regarding the interview. The District will also notify firms that are not selected. The District intends to utilize the CMGC project delivery method for this project. This selection is for design and engineering services during construction only. Selection of the CMGC Contractor will occur in the Fall of 2017.
