

NOTICE INVITING BIDS

RECEIPT OF BIDS: Sealed bids will be received at the office of General Manager of the Central Utah Water Conservancy District, (the "OWNER" of the work), 355 West University Parkway, Orem, Utah 84058, until **10:00 AM MST on Tuesday, February 21, 2017**, for furnishing plant, materials, and labor and performing all work for construction of the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline – Spanish Fork Reach for the Central Utah Water Conservancy District. The award, if made, will be within thirty (30) days after the opening of bids. Notice is additionally hereby given that Prequalification Proposals for the entire approximately 17.5 mile length of the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline, of which the Spanish Fork Reach is a portion, will be received at the office of General Manager of the Central Utah Water Conservancy District, (the "OWNER" of the work), 355 West University Parkway, Orem, Utah 84058, until **4:00 PM MST on Wednesday, December 21, 2016**.

PRE-QUALIFICATION: CONTRACTOR PRE-QUALIFICATION IS REQUIRED BY THE OWNER, and only pre-qualified bidders will be allowed to submit a sealed bid. Tunnel subcontractors will require prequalification under a separate process. General contractors will only be able to list and include prequalified tunnel subcontractors in their bids.

The PRE-QUALIFICATION STATEMENT must be obtained from the Construction Manager, completed in full and submitted and evaluated and approved by the Owner before a bidder can submit a bid.

All prospective Contractors will be advised at least 20 working days ahead of the bid due date if they have been approved to bid on this project and will be provided a list of prequalified tunnel subcontractors. General contractors approved to bid will be requested to submit sealed bids on each reach of this project based on the final specifications.

CONTRACTORS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A D-U-N-S® NUMBER: Contractors bidding on the Project will be required to obtain and submit a "Data Universal Number System" D-U-N-S® Number that is issued by Dunn and Bradstreet (D&B).

Contractors submitting bids on this project will be required to certify that neither the bidder nor any of its principals is presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participation in any program or project which is 100 percent or partially funded with federal funds.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The construction work for the initial reach of the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline, in general, consists of furnishing and installing the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline – Spanish Fork Reach consisting of approximately 8,480 feet of 60-inch steel pipeline, each with welded joints, mortar lining, and tape and mortar coating; approximately 230 feet of 72-inch jacked casings under two Union Pacific railroads, modification of existing concrete structure, asphalt paving, earthwork and other appurtenances and *related* work.

SITE OF WORK: The work for the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline - Spanish Fork Reach is located in Utah County, Utah. Except for the first 150 feet of pipe which is in Mapleton, and the last 2,000 feet of pipe, which is in unincorporated Utah County, the

pipeline is entirely within Spanish Fork City limits. It begins at the District's ULS Isolation Valve/Flushing Station on US 89 Highway, runs west and south, crossing US Hwy 89, two railroads, US Hwy 6 and State Route 198; then south in 3400 E St., southwest on River Bottom Rd., and then south along the west boundary of the Spanish Fork City's Spanish Oaks Golf Course, ending just south of Spanish Fork River near the intersection of Spanish Oaks Drive and Powerhouse Road.

COMPLETION OF WORK: Work under this contract will begin on or before the tenth day after receiving written Notice to Proceed from the Owner.

The work must be fully completed by June 30, 2018.

OPENING OF BIDS: The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud **at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, February 21, 2017.** Any bid received from a bidder who is not pre-qualified or received after the closing time for receipt of bids will be returned unopened.

OBTAINING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS: The Contract Documents are entitled "Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline – Spanish Fork Reach".

Those interested in purchasing individual sets of Contract Documents may obtain all Contract Documents from the Construction Manager at the above address. The *non-refundable* cost for all Volumes of the Contract Documents is \$100.00.

This Contract is for a Federally Funded Project, and the prevailing rate of wages, as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, shall be paid for each craft or type of workman needed to perform the Contract.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 and to the Equal Employment Opportunity and Labor Standard Provisions. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the Specifications.

Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Notice Inviting Bids or any resulting contracts.

The Contractor shall complete and sign the Affirmative Action Certification as part of his bid submittal.

BID SECURITY: Each Bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or a bid bond (acceptable to the Owner), in the amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the lump sum bid amount, payable without condition to the Owner as a guarantee that the bidder, if awarded the Contract, will promptly execute such Contract in accordance with the Bid and in manner and form required by the Contract Documents, and will furnish good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the same. The bid securities of the three (3) lowest bidders will be retained until the Contract is signed and satisfactory bonds furnished, or other disposition made thereof. The bid securities of all bidders except the three (3) lowest will be promptly returned after the canvass of bids.

BIDS TO REMAIN OPEN: The Bidder shall guarantee the Total Bid Price for a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the date of bid opening.

PRE-BID SITE VISIT and PRE-BID CONFERENCE: A mandatory pre-bid site visit will be held on **Wednesday, February 1, 2017** to field review the proposed construction area, which will include a question and answer period. This mandatory pre-bid conference will start at **10:00 am at the Central Utah Water Conservancy District's Utah Lake System Field Office at 4801 South Highway 89, Mapleton, Utah, 84664.**

The purpose of this meeting will be to clarify the intent of the Plans and Specifications for the Spanish Fork Reach and to answer any questions bidders and/or suppliers may have on the project. ***Only those bidders who have been pre-qualified and have attended the pre-bid conference will be allowed to submit bids.***

PROJECT ADMINISTRATION: All communication related to the WORK shall be directed to the Construction Manager prior to opening of Bid.
