

**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE INVITING BIDS TO**  
**SPANISH FORK SANTAQUIN PIPELINE**

**RECEIPT OF BIDS:** Sealed bids will be received at the office of General Manager of the Central Utah Water Conservancy District, (the “OWNER” of the work), 1426 E 750 N, Suite 400, Orem, Utah 84097, until **10:00 a.m. MST on Tuesday, April 23, 2019**, for furnishing plant, materials, and labor and performing all work for construction of the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline – Salem Reach 2 for the Central Utah Water Conservancy District. The award, if made, will be within thirty (30) days after the opening of bids.

**PRE-QUALIFICATION:** CONTRACTOR PRE-QUALIFICATION IS REQUIRED BY THE OWNER, and only pre-qualified bidders will be allowed to submit a sealed bid. The Contractor pre-qualification deadline for the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline – all reaches was December 21, 2016, resulting in the following list of pre-qualified contractors: 1) Condie Construction, 2) COP Construction, 3) VanCon Construction, 4) Whitaker Construction, and 5) W.W. Clyde & Co.

**CONTRACTORS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A D-U-N-S® NUMBER:** Contractors bidding on the Project will be required to obtain and submit a “Data Universal Number System” D-U-N-S® Number that is issued by Dunn and Bradstreet (D&B).

Contractors submitting bids on this Project will be required to certify that neither the bidder nor any of its principals are presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participation in any program or project which is 100 percent or partially funded with federal funds.

**DESCRIPTION OF WORK:** The construction work for the Salem Reach 2 of the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline, in general, consists of furnishing and installing approximately 7,500 feet of 60-inch steel pipeline with welded joints, mortar lining, and tape and mortar coating; one air-vac structure, and one blow off structure. The project also includes replacing a segment of the Salem Canal with approximately 5,300 feet of HDPE pipe ranging from 42-inches to 24-inches in diameter and multiple turnout structures.

**SITE OF WORK:** The work for the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline – Salem Reach 2 is in Utah County, Utah. The work is in unincorporated Utah County, and Payson City. The majority of the pipeline follows the Salem Canal Road and begins at Elk Ridge Drive, ending near 400 South 700 East, Payson.

**COMPLETION OF WORK:** Work under this Contract will begin on or before the tenth day after receiving written Notice to Proceed from the Owner.

The work must be fully completed by July 31, 2020.

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**OPENING OF BIDS:** The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud **at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 23, 2019.** Any bid received from a bidder who is not pre-qualified or received after the closing time for receipt of bids will be returned unopened.

**OBTAINING CONTRACT DOCUMENTS:** The Contract Documents are entitled “Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline – Salem Reach 2.”

Those interested in purchasing an electronic set of Contract Documents may obtain all Contract Documents electronically from the Construction Manager at the above address. The nonrefundable cost for an electronic copy of all Volumes of the Contract Documents is \$20.

This Contract is for a Federally Funded Project, and the prevailing rate of wages, as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, shall be paid for each craft or type of workman needed to perform the Contract.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President’s Executive Order No. 11246 and to the Equal Employment Opportunity and Labor Standard Provisions. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the Specifications.

Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Notice Inviting Bids or any resulting contracts.

The Contractor shall complete and sign the Affirmative Action Certification as part of his bid submittal.

**BID SECURITY:** Each Bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier’s check, or a bid bond (acceptable to the Owner), in the amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the lump sum bid amount, payable without condition to the Owner as a guarantee that the bidder, if awarded the Contract, will promptly execute such Contract in accordance with the Bid and in manner and form required by the Contract Documents, and will furnish good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the same. The bid securities of the three (3) lowest bidders will be retained until the Contract is signed and satisfactory bonds furnished, or other disposition made thereof. The bid securities of all bidders except the three (3) lowest will be promptly returned after the canvass of bids.

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**BIDS TO REMAIN OPEN:** The Bidder shall guarantee the Total Bid Price for a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the date of bid opening.

**PRE-BID SITE VISIT and PRE-BID CONFERENCE:** A **mandatory** pre-bid site visit will be held on **Tuesday, April 2, 2019** to field review the proposed construction area, which will include a question and answer period. This **mandatory** pre-bid conference will start at **10:00 am at the Central Utah Water Conservancy District’s Utah Lake System Field Office at 4801 South Highway 89, Mapleton, Utah 84664.**

The purpose of this meeting will be to clarify the intent of the Plans and Specifications for the Salem Reach 2 and to answer any questions bidders and/or suppliers may have on the project. **Only those bidders who have been pre-qualified and have attended the pre-bid conference will be allowed to submit bids.**

**PROJECT ADMINISTRATION:** All communication related to the Work shall be directed to the Construction Manager prior to opening of Bid.
