

## **NOTICE INVITING PROPOSALS FOR CONTRACTOR PREQUALIFICATION**

**RECEIPT OF PROPOSALS:** Proposals for contractor prequalification for the “**North Shore Terminal Reservoir Phase II Project**” (“Project”) for the Central Utah Water Conservancy District (“Owner”) will be received electronically via the QuestCDN website at <http://www.questcdn.com/>, until 2:00 PM MST on Friday, April 23th, 2021.

**PRE-QUALIFICATION:** Prequalification is mandatory and only prequalified contractors will be allowed to submit bids.

**DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:** The Project work, in general, includes construction of a 15 million gallon (MG) rectangular cast-in-place concrete finished-water storage reservoir with conventional reinforcement, complete and operational, including all testing, training, warranty and startup services, and all other work necessary to complete the Project in accordance with the final drawings and specifications. The work will also include earthwork, site piping to connect to existing onsite facilities, and renovation of an existing building, with accompanying work and appurtenances.

**OVERALL PROJECT SCHEDULE:** Prequalification proposals will be evaluated after the submission deadline and proposers will be notified of prequalification status by May 7, 2021. Bidding documents will be available in July and final bids will be due in August. The construction work will begin in September 2021 is anticipated to extend through the summer of 2023.

**SITE OF WORK:** The work is located on the Owner’s property at approximately 1200 West Military Road in the City of Saratoga Springs, Utah.
