SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE INVITING BIDS TO
SPANISH FORK SANTAQUIN PIPELINE

RECEIPT OF BIDS: Sealed bids will be received at the office of General Manager of the Central Utah Water Conservancy District, (the “OWNER” of the work), 1426 E. 750 N., Suite 400, Orem, Utah 84097, until **10:00 a.m. MDT on Tuesday, April 20, 2021**, for furnishing materials, and labor and performing all work for construction of the Sixth Water Flow Control Structure Modification Project for the Central Utah Water Conservancy District. The award, if made, will be within thirty (30) days after the opening of bids.

PRE-QUALIFICATION: CONTRACTOR PRE-QUALIFICATION IS REQUIRED BY THE OWNER, and only pre-qualified bidders will be allowed to submit a sealed bid. The 2016 and 2020 Contractor pre-qualifications for the ULS Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline resulted in the following list of pre-qualified contractors: 1) Ames Construction, 2) Condie Construction, 3) COP Construction, 4) S J Louis Construction, 5) Sundt Construction, 6) VanCon Construction, 7) Whitaker Construction, and 8) W.W. Clyde & Co.

CONTRACTORS REQUIRED TO SUBMIT A D-U-N-S® NUMBER: Contractors bidding on the Project will be required to obtain and submit a “Data Universal Number System” D-U-N-S® Number that is issued by Dunn and Bradstreet (D&B). Contractors submitting bids on this Project will be required to certify that neither the bidder nor any of its principals are presently debarred, suspended, proposed for debarment, declared ineligible, or voluntarily excluded from participation in any program or project which is 100 percent or partially funded with federal funds.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: The construction work for the Spanish Fork North Turnout, in general, consists of furnishing and installing and testing of a flow control station on the existing 60-inch steel ULS pipeline including vault, steel piping, valves, meter, controls, fiberoptics, cathodic protection, surface improvements, and other Work.

SITE OF WORK: The work for the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline – Spanish Fork North Turnout Project is in Spanish Fork City, Utah County, Utah. It on City land being sold to developer D R Horton. It is accessed from a gravel road at 3450 E 7600 S that is north of US Hwy 6 and the abutting railroad.

COMPLETION OF WORK: Work under this Contract will begin on or before the tenth day after receiving written Notice to Proceed from the Owner. The work must be fully completed by April 29, 2022.

OPENING OF BIDS: The bids will be publicly opened and read aloud **at 10:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 20, 2021**. Any bid received from a bidder who is not pre-qualified or received after the closing time for receipt of bids will be returned unopened.

Interested bidders may obtain an electronic copy of the Bidding Documents at www.questcdn.com under **Project Number: 7677192**. The documents may be downloaded for a fee. The District will not provide any paper copies of the Bidding Documents.

This Contract is for a Federally Funded Project, and the prevailing rate of wages, as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, shall be paid for each craft or type of workman needed to perform the Contract.

Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246 and to the Equal Employment Opportunity and Labor Standard Provisions. The requirements for bidders and contractors under this order are explained in the Specifications. Neither the United States nor any of its departments, agencies, or employees is or will be a party to this Notice Inviting Bids or any resulting contracts. The Contractor shall complete and sign the Affirmative Action Certification as part of his bid submittal.

BID SECURITY: Each Bid shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, or a bid bond (acceptable to the Owner), in the amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the lump sum bid amount, payable without condition to the Owner as a guarantee that the bidder, if awarded the Contract, will promptly execute such Contract in accordance with the Bid and in manner and form required by the Contract Documents, and will furnish good and sufficient bond for the faithful performance of the same. The bid securities of the three (3) lowest bidders will be retained until the Contract is signed and satisfactory bonds furnished, or other disposition made thereof. The bid securities of all bidders except the three (3) lowest will be promptly returned after the canvass of bids.

BIDS TO REMAIN OPEN: The Bidder shall guarantee the Total Bid Price for a period of thirty (30) calendar days from the date of bid opening.

PRE-BID CONFERENCE: A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held **Tuesday, April 6, 2021** to review the proposed construction. It will include a question and answer period. This mandatory pre-bid conference will be hosted at **10:00 a.m. at the Central Utah Water Conservancy District's Office at 1426 E. 750 N, Suite 400, Orem, Utah 84097.**

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The purpose of this meeting will be to clarify the intent of the Plans and Specifications for the Spanish Fork North Turnout Project and to answer any questions bidders and/or suppliers may have on the project. **Only those bidders who have been pre-qualified and have attended the pre-bid conference will be allowed to submit bids.**

PROJECT ADMINISTRATION: All communication related to the Work shall be directed to the Construction Manager prior to opening of Bid.
