 - Outside employment (AC §7102)
- Nepotism prohibited except under certain situations approved by state law (AC §7200, Utah Code [§52-3-1](#))
- Improper influence (AC §89804)
- Collusion (AC §89805)
- Sales taxes (AC §89806)
- Gifts, gratuities, loans (AC §89807, Utah Code [§67-16-5](#))
- Personal Purchases (AC §89808)
- Misuse of public resources or property (AC §9502, Utah Code [§76-8-4](#))
- Political activity (AC §7102, AC §9502)
- Fair and equal treatment (AC §8701.02)
- Conduct after leaving office or employment (AC §2301, AC §11009)
