NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE
Central Utah Water Conservancy District
IN SUMMIT COUNTY

The Central Utah Water Conservancy District is proposing to increase its property tax revenue.

-The Central Utah Water Conservancy District tax on a \$202,000 residence would increase from \$42.44 to \$44.44, which is \$2.00 per year.

-The Central Utah Water Conservancy District tax on a \$202,000 business would increase from \$77.16 to \$80.80, which is \$3.64 per year.

-If the proposed budget is approved, Central Utah Water Conservancy District would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by 7.56% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding new growth.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on the tax increase.
