NOTICE OF PROPOSED TAX INCREASE  
Central Utah Water Conservancy District  
IN WASATCH COUNTY

The Central Utah Water Conservancy District is proposing to increase its property tax revenue.

-The Central Utah Water Conservancy District tax on a \$513,000 residence would increase from \$107.78 to \$112.86, which is \$5.08 per year.

-The Central Utah Water Conservancy District tax on a \$513,000 business would increase from \$195.97 to \$205.20, which is \$9.23 per year.

-If the proposed budget is approved, Central Utah Water Conservancy District would increase its property tax budgeted revenue by -7.03% above last year's property tax budgeted revenue excluding new growth.

All concerned citizens are invited to a public hearing on the tax increase.
