

The Central Utah Water Conservancy District (CUWCD), the Department of the Interior, and the Utah Reclamation Mitigation and Conservation Commission, as joint lead agencies (JLAs), are notifying the public and agencies of the release of the Draft Environmental Assessment (Draft EA) for the Diamond Fork System Environmental Update Project (Project) for review and comment. The Project consists of the adjusting instream flow deliveries to Sixth Water and Diamond Fork Creeks to support and sustain functional fluvial, geomorphic, and ecological processes; provide the flexibility necessary to meet inspection and maintenance requirements of the Diamond Fork System to continue the delivery of contracted water and instream flows; and prevent the continuous corrosion of the Upper Diamond Fork Flow Control Structure from nearby hydrogen sulfide springs.
