

NOTICE INVITING SUPPLEMENTAL PREQUALIFICATION
SPANISH FORK SANTAQUIN PIPELINE, UTAH

RECEIPT OF SUPPLEMENTAL PREQUALIFICATION STATEMENTS: Supplemental Prequalification Statements will be received at the office of General Manager of the Central Utah Water Conservancy District, (the "OWNER" of the work), 1426 E 750 N, Suite 400, Orem, Utah 84097, until **4:00 PM MST on Wednesday, December 9, 2020**, for furnishing plant, materials, and labor and performing all work for construction of the remaining reaches of the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline for the Central Utah Water Conservancy District. The original prequalification for the 17.5-mile Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline was conducted in December 2016. Five construction firms were prequalified at that time. Approximately 8.5 miles of the pipeline has been designed and awarded for construction. Due the length of time that has passed since the original prequalification period, a Supplemental Prequalification solicitation period has been added for the remaining approximately 9 miles of the 60-inch welded steel pipeline, along with approximately 5 miles of 42-48 inch HDPE pipeline.

PRE-QUALIFICATION: CONTRACTOR PRE-QUALIFICATION IS REQUIRED BY THE OWNER, and only pre-qualified bidders will be allowed to submit a sealed bid. Tunnel subcontractors will require prequalification under a separate process. General contractors will only be able to list and include prequalified tunnel subcontractors in their bids.

The PRE-QUALIFICATION STATEMENT must be obtained from the Construction Manager beginning on November 3, 2020 or the District website, www.cuwcd.com, completed in full and submitted by December 9, 2020 and approved by the Owner before a bidder can submit a bid. Bidding on the next pipeline sub-reach is expected to occur in the spring of 2021.

SITE OF WORK: The work for the Spanish Fork Santaquin Pipeline remaining reaches is located within unincorporated Utah County, Salem City and Santaquin City

This Contract is for a Federally Funded Project, and the prevailing rate of wages, as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with the Davis-Bacon Act, shall be paid for each craft or type of workman needed to perform the Contract.
