

**NOTICE OF
REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS
FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES**

The Central Utah Water Conservancy District (“OWNER”) is soliciting technical proposals from interested engineering firms to provide engineering design, consultation, and services during construction for the CWP High Head Well Project, Wells 16 & 17 (“Project”), part of the overall Central Utah Water Conservancy District Water Development Project (“CWP”).

SCOPE OF SERVICES: Services provided by the consulting engineer will include the following tasks for each well: (1) preparation and acceptance of a preliminary evaluation report (PER), assistance with preparation and adoption of source protection, and design of the well, casing, well screens, and all below ground installations, and well completion report; (2) engineering services and field inspection during the drilling of the well; (3) design and supervision of the well testing and development programs, including regulatory permitting and approvals; (4) design of the well house, connections, metering, chlorination equipment, water quality instrumentation, cathodic protection, electrical, SCADA and controls, and appurtenant facilities; (5) engineering services and field inspection during construction for the well houses and facilities, including start-up of the well facilities; and, (6) coordination and assistance to Owner in obtaining operating permit and final approval from Division of Drinking Water. All design and construction for the wells must conform to the most recent State of Utah well drilling and drinking water standards and regulations for developing water sources. Coordination with cities, state and federal agencies, utilities companies, and other interested parties is an essential part of the Project.

PROJECT LOCATION: The project is located at two separate sites that are each located within the Town of Vineyard, Utah.

PROPOSALS DUE: Proposals from interested firms shall be submitted through www.questcdn.com and must be uploaded before **1:00 P.M. on Wednesday, September 30, 2020**.

SELECTION: A District selection committee will review the Proposals and select the most qualified firm for the Project. Award of the engineering design and services contract for the Project will occur at the Board of Trustees meeting on October 28, 2020.
