

Alpine Aqueduct Reach 1 Replacement and Resiliency Project Notice of Public Meeting and Comment Period

The Central Utah Water Conservancy District (District) and the Department of the Interior – Central Utah Project Completion Act Office, as Joint Lead Agencies, have initiated an Environmental Assessment (EA) to evaluate the replacement of a 1.4-mile segment of the Alpine Aqueduct at the mouth of Provo Canyon in Orem and the potential addition of pump stations. The study, in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act, is being conducted to evaluate these potential improvements to protect this critical pipeline from geological hazards, such as landslides and earthquakes. The District is initiating the scoping as part of the EA process. The public is invited to attend a Scoping Meeting on Tuesday, Nov. 30, 2021, from 6-7:30 p.m. to learn more about this effort and provide input to the project team. The meeting will be held at the Central Utah Water Conservancy District offices in Orem (1426 East 750 North, Building 2 Orem, UT 84097). The Scoping Document will be available for review starting on Nov. 15, 2021, and can be accessed online at the project website (cuwcd.com/alpineaqueduct.html) or in-person at the District's Orem office.
